



Gifts & Legacies

Please remember your Church in your Will?

Your Catholic Church in Farnham has benefitted from legacies over many years - for example:

- The generous bequests from the Borelli family funded the original altar and improvements in the Church,
- While half of the cost of the Parish Centre came from the substantial legacy from the Wright Family.

In recent years we have received some legacies which have gone to benefit the current generation of St Joan's parishioners.

Looking to the future, we ask that you consider making provision in your will, to aid future generations of worshippers at St Joan's.

The process is very simple:

If you already have a Will, you can help the Parish by adding a codicil to your existing Will - suggested wording is overleaf.

We do advise consulting with your solicitor or legal adviser before completing this codicil form overleaf.

We suggest that you do not write on or amend your current Will, or it could become invalid.

If you do not have a Will, you are strongly advised to do so as this can cause many difficulties for your survivors.

It is advisable to consult local solicitors to help draft a Will.

If you are prepared to remember your Church in your Will, there are 2 possible options for you:

Pecuniary Gift

This is a specified amount of money to be left to the Parish.

Specific Gift

This is a gift of a particular item of value (e.g. funds to purchase a Chalice or vestments etc).

By remembering your Church in your Will, you enable future generations to sustain and grow the Catholic family in Farnham. All donors are remembered annually in or Donor Mass.
